About the Boardman Park's Adventure Day Camp Scholarship Program

Boardman Park understands parks and recreation services are essential for our community's quality of life. The Park believes every citizen should have the opportunity to participate in the programs and services provided by the Parks and Recreation Department. The scholarship program is designed to help Boardman residents in need take advantage of these programs and services.

Boardman Park's Adventure Day Camp Scholarship Guidelines

- Boardman Park's Adventure Day Camp Scholarship Program is limited to residents living within the limits of Boardman Township **and** is open to any student ages 6-12 years of age.
- Scholarship eligibility is determined by participation in the Boardman School's Free/Reduced lunch program OR determined by current family hardships such as illness and or death of an immediate family member.
- Scholarships are awarded for Boardman Park's Adventure Day Camp program registration fees; supplies and other costs are not eligible for scholarship consideration.
- Scholarships may be granted for the full fee or for a percentage of the fee. Each application is considered on an individual basis for the amount to be awarded.
- The scholarship award may not exceed \$500 per calendar year per individual. There is ONLY one (1) Scholarship per Household.
- The funds are to be used ONLY for Boardman Park's Adventure Day Camp between the hours of 9am to 3pm. Any extra hours or fees are at the responsibility of the applicant; applicant must provide their own lunch.
- Funds for the scholarship program are limited. The funds will be distributed at the sole discretion of Boardman Park.
- Completing a scholarship application does not guarantee a spot in the program for your child
- All scholarships are subject to the availability of funds and camp space.
- Participants must be in attendance for not less than 80 percent of the Camp Days for which they receive scholarship funds in order to be eligible to receive funds the following year.
- Camper must be in good discipline status from the previous year, as well as if the camper receives any Major or Severe Infractions this scholarship will be revoked.

How to apply for a Boardman Park's Adventure Day Camp Scholarship

- Complete the application form.
- Attach a request letter explaining your circumstances.
- Attach a copy of your driver's license or document showing your Boardman address.
- Fill out online Camp registration (www.boardmanparkcamp.com), leaving payment as "check"/open balance.

Scholarships applications are due by May 29. Scholarships are announced by June 2. Any applications received after June 3 may not receive funding.

The applicant will be notified whether the application was approved and for what amount.
